Notice is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting of the Heritage Crafts Association (HCA) will be held at Cecil Sharp House, 2 Regent's Park Road, London, NW1 7AY on Saturday 9 March 2019 at 1.10pm.

The Annual General Meeting of the HCA is called to:

- Receive the Annual Report and the examined Financial Statement contained therein
- Consider and vote upon any resolutions of which due notice has been given
- Elect Trustees and Officers
- Discuss informally any other business with the permission of the Chair

Members of the HCA are entitled to propose resolutions for consideration at the AGM. These should be submitted in writing, proposed and seconded by HCA members. The final date for receipt of resolutions by the HCA Administrator is Friday 15 February 2019.

Members of the HCA are also entitled to submit nominations for the Board of Trustees. These should be submitted in writing, with a brief CV of the proposed nominee, with permission of the nominee and signed by a proposer and seconder. Nominee, proposer and seconder must all be separate and current HCA members. The final date for receipt of nominations by the HCA Administrator is Friday 15 February 2019.
