

Town Hall Access

The main entrance to the Town Hall is in St Aldate's. Eight steps lead up to the entrance foyer.

There is a level entrance approximately 28 metres to the north along St Aldate's. The outer glass door at this entrance opens automatically to allow access to an inner entrance. CCTV linked to the Town Hall reception desk monitors this inner door. To the left of the inner glass door is a call button that will attract the receptionist's attention to allow access to the Town Hall ground floor.



On entering the ground floor to the right is a double door through which is access to the reception desk and lift to the first floor.

Lift Information

The lift can accommodate electric scooters. The lift entrance is 80cm wide with internal dimensions of 1.3m x 2.8m.

The following rooms are accessible without assistance:-

Main Hall	St Aldate's Room
Assembly Room	Panel Room
Old Library	Plowman Room
Council Chamber	Lord Mayor's Parlour

Toilet Facilities

The Town Hall has three wheelchair accessible toilets. They are located:

- On the ground floor near the other public toilets opposite the Museum shop
- In the council corridor opposite the Lord Mayor's Parlour.
- At the rear of the Main Hall. Access to this toilet is available from both the Main Hall and the first floor landing. When the double doors from the landing are closed, persons with mobility difficulties may have to obtain assistance when using this route.

All toilets have an emergency pull cord and buzzer to attract staff.
